Infection Control Safety Policy

The Medical Room requires that all contractors be aware of their obligations in respect of Infection Control Safety to ensure that we meet national standards in respect of infection control matters.

The following requirements must be maintained at all times:

The prevention and management of acquired infection is a key priority for the The Medical Room Ltd and the Trust that you have been assigned to. The Contractor is required to ensure, as an employee, that his/her work methods are compliant with the Trust's agreed policies and procedures and do not endanger other people or themselves:

- All Contractors must be aware of their Trust's local infection prevention and control policies, practices and guidelines appropriate for their duties and must follow these at all times to maintain a safe environment for patients, visitors and staff;
- All Contractors must maintain an up to date knowledge of their local Trust's infection prevention and control, policies, practices and procedures through attendance at annual mandatory updates and ongoing continuing professional development;
- Any breach of infection control policies is a serious matter which may result in disciplinary action;
- All Contractors have a responsibility to challenge poor infection prevention and control practices of others and to report any breaches, using appropriate local Trust mechanisms (e.g. incident reporting policy).

All Contractors must sign and return one copy of this document to confirm their awareness and acceptance of this policy.
